Encompassing the countries of South Africa, Botswana, Namibia, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Mozambique, Swaziland and Lesotho, Southern Africa contains tremendous variety and contrasts. Witness the mighty Zambezi tumbling over Victoria Falls, versus the shallow floodplains of the Okavango Delta. Compare the shimmering orange sand dunes of Namibia with a rugged South African coastline inhabited by whales and dolphins. And there is ever so much more. The

region has such unique habitats and diverse cultures, each speaking a multitude of languages, that you could spend years exploring Southern Africa alone. There is more here to see and experience than a lifetime could encompass.

SAFARIS IN SOUTHERN AFRICA

For the most part, lodges and camps in Southern Africa accommodate only a limited number of guests, giving you an intimate and select wildlife experience. Exclusivity comes with a price. Yet the low impact, high revenue tourism model implemented by Botswana is nevertheless very attractive, so you will want to plan your Botswana safari well in advance. South Africa has a more diverse range of accommodation in every price bracket, while Namibia, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Malawi are more remote with less choices, but equally as wonderful.
